Dear Parents,

Welcome back to school for Term 3. There was a good deal of progress during the holidays with our building project and all of the transportable buildings (with the exception of the library) have now been demolished. The next stage of the project will involve landscaping the area on the lower level closest to the Cobbler Creek playground and then construction works will begin. The demolition of the library will not occur until our new buildings are in use.

This term we welcome two new staff members. Jamie Kriticos is working in the school Wednesday-Friday while Clare Kirby takes maternity leave and Mackenzie Brown joins us to teach Japanese to all classes from Reception to Year 6. Mackenzie's position replaces the teaching roles of Huong Do who has taken leave, leading to retirement and Claudia Brewis who is now working full time at Golden Grove High School.

Teaching of Languages

Many parents will already be aware that each South Australian Government school teaches a language from Reception to Year 8. Languages are offered from Year 9 to 12 but are optional subjects.

At present, all primary schools along the Golden Way offer Japanese and the Golden Grove High School offers both Japanese and Spanish.

Our school has a long history of teaching Japanese. However with the pending retirement of our Japanese teacher Huong Do, we are keen to seek your opinion regarding the future of language teaching in our school.

In coming days, you will receive an email asking you to complete a survey regarding which language you would prefer to be offered at GGPS from 2023. Would you like our school to continue offering Japanese, would you like us to consider the other GGHS offering of Spanish or would you like Auslan (which was introduced briefly last semester) to be offered?

We look forward to your survey input. In the meantime, you will find additional information over the page regarding the teaching of languages.

We all have a role to play to ensure that children get the best education possible, and this starts with ensuring that **all** children attend school **all** day, **every** school day.

Attendance is a priority at Golden Grove Primary School. The more students attend, the more they learn and the more they will like school.

Research also indicates that **regular attendance** leads to:

- Developing skills and attitudes such as self-discipline, punctuality, organisation and sticking to routines
- Making friends and learning how to maintain relationships over a period of time
- Learning social skills necessary to live and work with others

Parents/Caregivers are required to:

- Ensure that all children attend school from the beginning of each day (8:50am)
- Provide the school with an appropriate explanation for the student's nonattendance via a telephone call/SMS before 10am on the day of the absence
- Provide a medical certificate for extended absences (over 3 days) due to illness.
- Obtain a late slip from Student Services if students arrive after 8:50am and present to teacher on arrival at classroom
- Obtain an early dismissal slip from Student Services and present this to the classroom teacher if taking a child from school prior to 3:10pm
- Request a temporary exemption form from school for any known absences of five days or longer (ED175 forms available from the front office)
- Communicate to relevant school staff any needs or concerns which may affect a child's attendance

If your child is experiencing any barriers to attending school regularly, please contact me as soon as possible so that we can work together to address any issues.
