### **Student Wellbeing**

All children get anxious from time to time. In fact, it's a very normal and healthy reaction to stressful situations. However, when a child regularly feels anxious and these feelings are



intense, it can affect their health and happiness. For most children, anxiety is short lived. But for some, anxiety seems to 'take over', preventing them from enjoying friendships, school life and even family life.

I hear from many parents that it is extremely difficult to access support programs and/or psychological help for children (and themselves) coping with anxiety. I was therefore very pleased to be introduced to the BRAVE Program at a recent professional development day.

The BRAVE Program is an online, free of charge program designed to help young people to reduce anxiety and cope with stressful situations. The program is based on cognitive-behavioural therapy and addresses all types of anxiety including:

- Separation anxiety
- Generalised anxiety
- Social anxiety
- Phobias

The program has courses for children ranging from 3-17 years of age. There are 10 on-line modules for children to complete, with six accompanying parent information versions. Each module takes approximately 30-60 minutes to complete and it is recommended that engage with one module per week. The modules are fun, interactive and easy for children to navigate.

If your child is struggling with anxiety or would benefit from learning strategies to deal with stressful situations, I would highly recommend looking into The BRAVE Program. Please see details below.
