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Dear Families,

Welcome back to term 2! It has been outstanding to see how well our students have returned from the holiday break, getting straight back in to routines and their learning. Thank you for supporting us for our first pupil free day for this year on Monday the 29th of April. This was an invaluable time for all of our staff to review student learning and moderate samples student achievement across each year level. As well as sharing good practice, teaching staff were able to forward plan curriculum implementation for the year ahead.

Last Friday we hosted a remarkable ANZAC Day assembly under the COLA structure. Thank you to the families who were able to join us, as we welcomed special visitors from the defence force, including our invited guest Ms Rhiannon Pearce, member for King. HB18, HB19 and Tracey Langley (Defence School's Mentor) are to be commended for organising such an outstanding assembly.

Fittingly, we presented a 'Spirit of ANZAC' award to one member of each classroom who consistently displays the school values, in alliance with the ANZAC characteristics of courage, equity, endurance and mateship.



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ANZAC Day has a very special place in my family's history, as both of my Grandparents were deployed to serve in World War 2, with other ancestors also serving in World War 1. My Grandfather Dennis Fenton served in World War 2 as a Leading Aircraftman for the RAAF in Indonesia (my son Kai Dennis is named after him). Similarly my grandad Alvon Richardson (pictured) served as a Lance Corporal in the Australian Infantry Battalion. He was stationed in Bougainville and in the Solomon Islands after being deployed in August 1944 to round up and return Japanese prisoners of war in the historic Cowra break out. Sadly both of my grandparents have since passed away, however one of my proudest moments came in 2014 when I was privileged to wheel Grandad Alvon down North Terrace for the '100 year' ANZAC Day march (pictured). Although both my grandparents never spoke of their time serving our country, I often reflect on what they must have endured during the war and subsequent depression, and are eternally grateful for their sacrifices. Our children have a lot to be thankful for, and our assembly last Friday encapsulated that sentiment.

On behalf of the Golden Grove staff, I wish all the incredible superheros our there, the mothers and mother figures of our wonderful children, who do so much for them each and every day. I hope Mother's Day on Sunday is a fitting way to be acknowledged and celebrated for everything that you do.
