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### Term 1 Week 4, 24th February 2022

Dear Parents,

Well, it has been an interesting start to the school year! We currently have approximately 88% of our students attending each day, which is terrific, but there are still many families dealing with isolation and/or illness. We wish everybody all the best as they deal with the current challenges.

To date, we have contacted families by email in response to 15 positive cases who have been at school when possibly infectious. The "classroom contact" notification asks for families to monitor children for symptoms and for staff to (RAT) test daily but classroom contacts are still able to continue attending school if symptom free.

From Week 5 (next week) until Week 9, we have been advised by the Department for Education that schools may resume the activities listed below:

- Swimming lessons, excursions, sports days and interschool sport
- Choir, band practice, instrumental music lessons
- Camps (only those required by SACE)
- Assemblies that are held outdoors (this year, we will continue to ask only 1 parent per child of the presenting class or an award recipient to attend)

The COVID-19 settings that remain in place are:

- Face masks are to be worn by all adults
- Face masks are strongly encouraged for Year 3 – 6 students, when indoors
- Testing, isolating and quarantine requirements remain unchanged
- Classroom entry remains restricted to staff and students only

A Term Planner taking the above activities into account is available in this newsletter. These arrangements will be reviewed by the Department for Education prior to Week 9. We are hopeful that camps may resume for primary years students after this time and will advise Year 3, 4 & 6 families when and if we are able to re-book the camps that unfortunately were cancelled this term.
