I am excited to share the news that our building project will soon be underway to deliver a \$6 million infrastructure upgrade to our school. This upgrade will involve the demolition of all transportable buildings to make way for the construction of a new library and a new performing arts centre (see inside for an overview of our current performing arts program).

In the very near future, you will see temporary fencing installed around the building site and this will signal the commencement of the project. Prior to the demolition of the old buildings, hazardous materials including asbestos, will be removed from the buildings on weekends. Members of the public are therefore advised not to enter school grounds on the weekends beginning 28th May.

We are committed to minimising any impacts or distraction to learning programs and will work closely with the project managers to ensure all safety measures are in place.
