She loved running against other high level runners and having strong competition. James enjoyed competing in shot put. He tried his best and achieved a PB by throwing over 5m. Eli, Jake, Mason and Callum competed in the 2011 relay event. Mason said it was a fantastic day, they encouraged each other and tried their best. Jack competed in the 100m and 200m event. He finished 3rd in both events and came away with two bronze medals. As a result, Jack has been invited to nominate for the National Athletics competition in Brisbane later this year to represent South Australia.

During school holidays earlier in the year, Jack took part in soccer trials and training, for the English Premier League team; West Ham United. They sent 4 academy youth coaches from England to tour Australia and select players. During the trial in SA there were approximately 80 boys ranging in age from 6-16 years old. Jack was selected, with a handful other boys from SA, to travel to Queensland for the National Trial in September. During the National Camp there were over 400 children present. As well as playing soccer, there were lectures during the evenings, including meeting former West Ham player and Australian Soccer legend, Stan Lazaridis. Jack had lots of fun and learnt many new skills.

Jack is awaiting a decision from the National Camp, to see if he was lucky enough to have been chosen and invited to London in the UK, for further training and support in his soccer journey.
