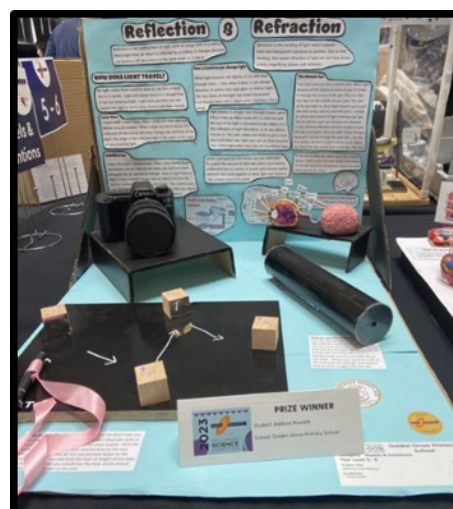
Mia Soraghan-Meijer and Jaelyn Ebert entered a life like cheetah skull and Addison Kowald entered a project on reflection and refraction.
